

#### This Week in Review – August 18, 2023

#### **Highlights from this week**

- The House and Senate voted to override the governor's veto of the following bills. These bills became law:
  - Parents' Bill of Rights. Requires school staff to notify parents of any change in the name or pronoun used by a student; requires schools to establish a process for parents to review materials for and to consent or withhold consent for participation in reproductive health and safety education programs.
  - <u>Charter School Omnibus</u>. It loosens approval and operational requirements and includes a statement that the board shall not consider any alleged impact on the local schools district(s) in the area when deciding to grant, renew, or terminate a charter.
  - <u>Fairness in Women's Sports Act</u>. The bill prevents trans women from competing in women's sports.
  - Charter School Review Board. Converts the Charter Schools Advisory Board into the Charter Schools Review Board. It shifts the authority to approve new charters from the State Board of Education to the new Review Board.
  - o Gender Transitions/Minors. The bill prohibits gender transition procedures for minors.

The chart below contains all education-related bills we're tracking and their latest status. Items in bold reflect action taken this week. Bills that made crossover are highlighted.
