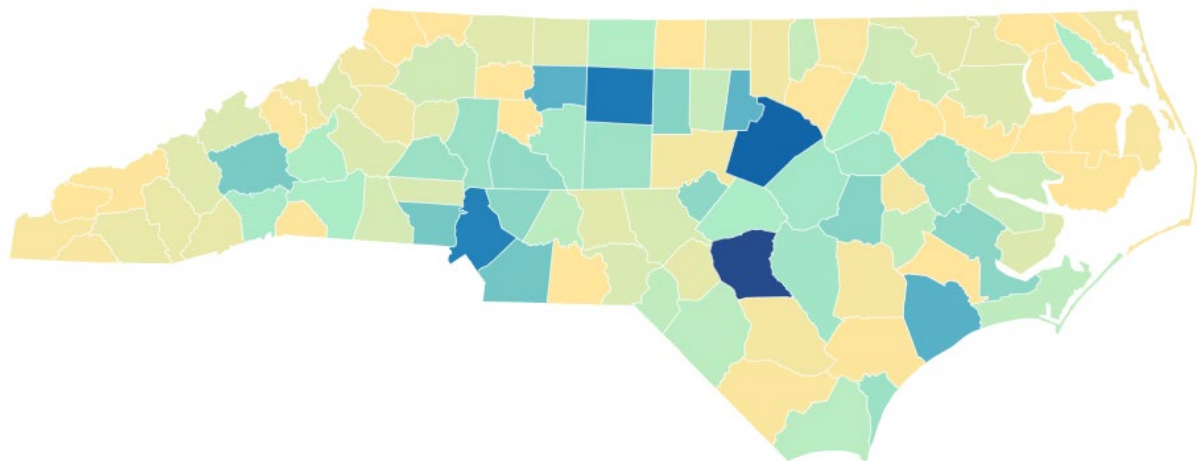




Dollars Spent on OS Vouchers 2014-15 through 2023-24

Since the launch of the Opportunity Scholarship voucher program in 2014-15, **North Carolina has spent more than \$614 million** on tuition at private schools instead of supporting public schools and educators across the state. Nearly half of all voucher funds have gone to private schools in just seven of NC's 100 counties. Rural counties are being forced to subsidize private schools in urban and suburban counties.
