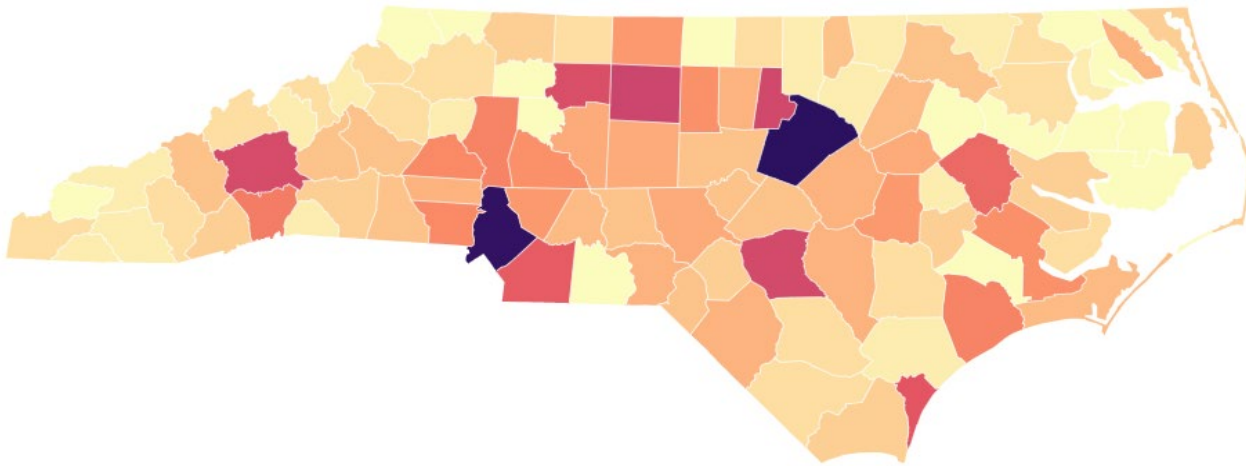




# North Carolina's Voucher Accepting Private Schools 2024-25

In 2024-25, North Carolina has 891 registered private schools. Of those schools, 627 are **direct payment schools** that are **eligible to receive voucher funds from the state**. The remaining 264 (30%) do not accept vouchers. Rural counties are being forced to subsidize private schools in urban and suburban counties.
