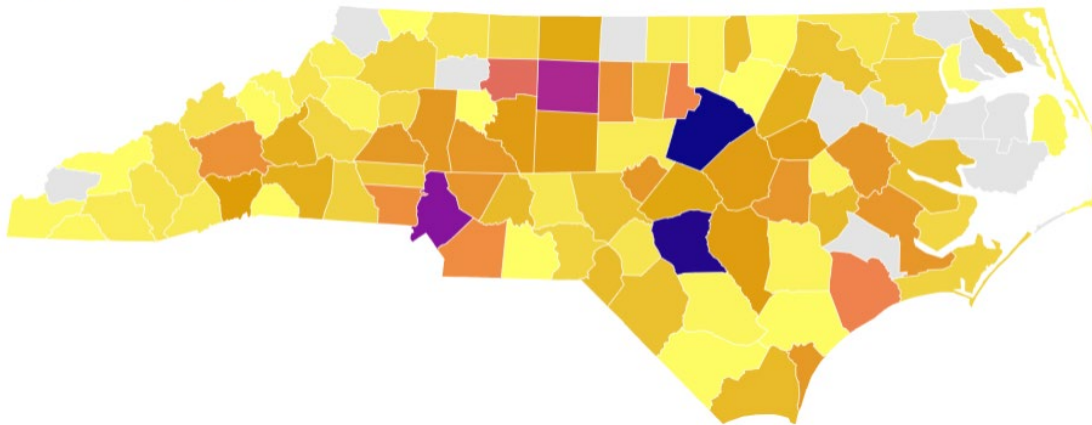


# Dollars Spent on School Vouchers 2014-15 to 2024-25

Since the launch of the taxpayer-funded Opportunity Scholarship voucher program in 2014-15, **North Carolina has spent nearly \$1 BILLION (\$997,641,505)** on tuition at private schools instead of supporting public schools and educators across the state. One-third of all voucher funds have gone to private schools in just four of North Carolina's 100 counties, and half has gone to just eight counties. **Rural counties are being forced to subsidize private schools in urban/suburban counties.** View an interactive map of the dollars sent to private schools by county [here](#).
