


Dollars Spent on OS Vouchers 2014-15 to 2024-25

Since the launch of the taxpayer-funded Opportunity Scholarship voucher program in 2014-15, **North Carolina has spent more than \$1 BILLION (\$1,046,535,839)** on tuition at private schools instead of supporting public schools and educators across the state. One-third of all voucher funds have gone to private schools in just four of North Carolina's 100 counties, and half has gone to just nine counties. Rural counties are being forced to subsidize private schools in urban/suburban counties. View an interactive map of the dollars sent to private schools within each county here.
