


NC Voucher Payments 2014-15 to 2025-26 (October Update)

Since launch of North Carolina's taxpayer funded voucher programs, the state *has spent more than \$1.4 BILLION* on tuition voucher payments to private schools and voucher payments to families. The voucher payments through the Opportunity Scholarship program account for 89% of the expenditures with the ESA+ vouchers making up the remaining 11%. Spending on voucher programs drains funds that could instead be used to support public schools and educators across the state.
